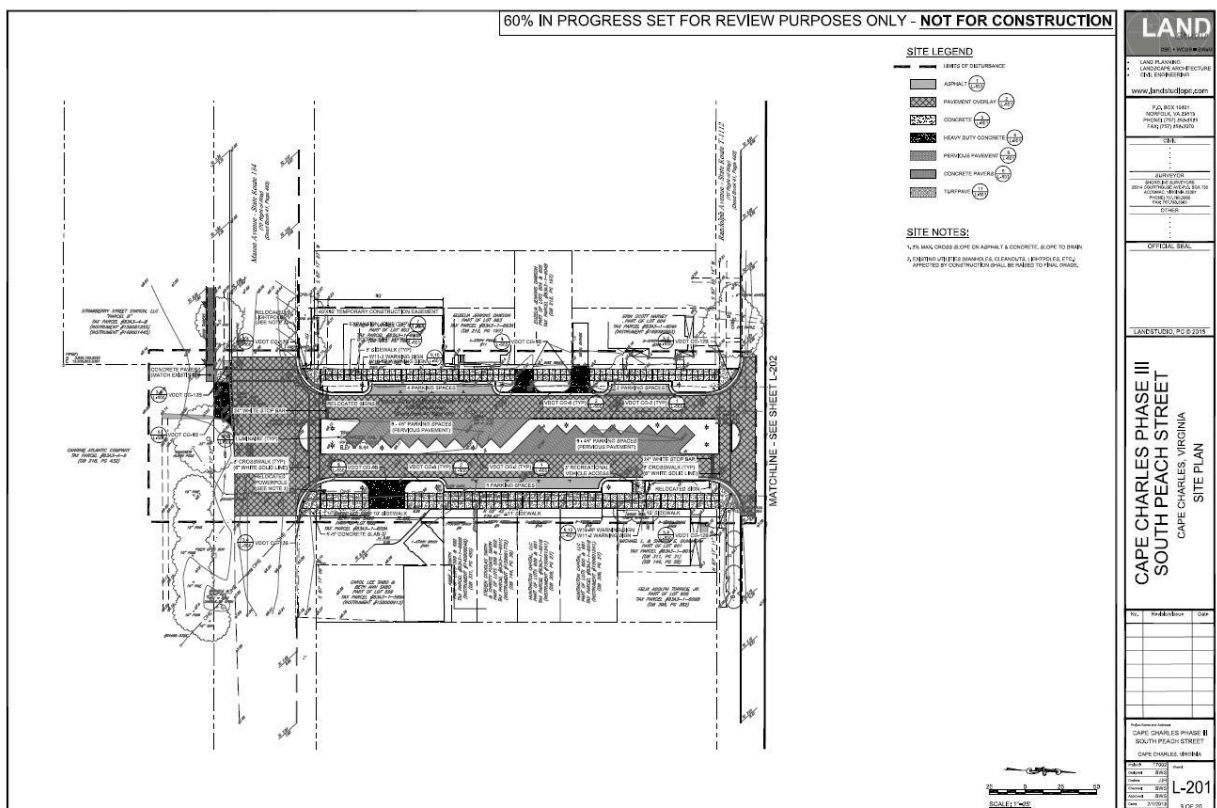
## CAPE CHARLES COMMUNITY TRAIL, PHASE 3

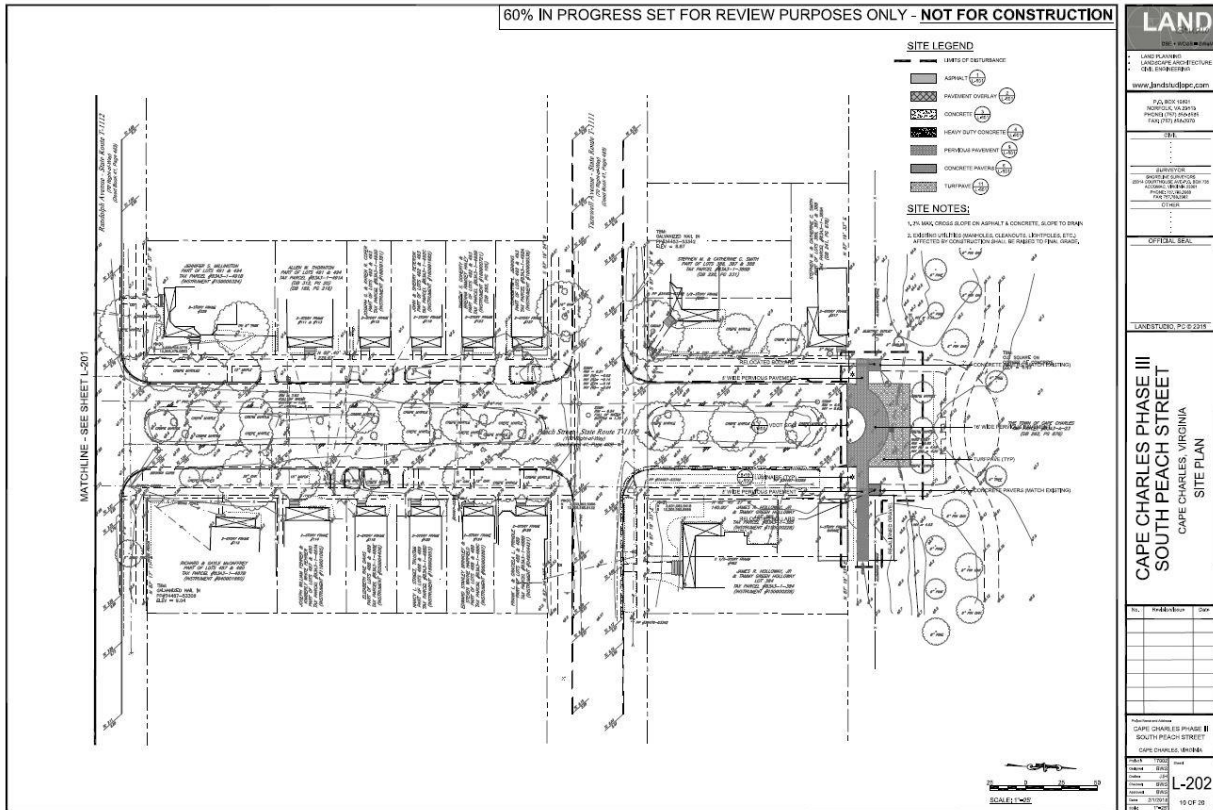
Phase 3 of the Community Trail will encompass improvements to the block of south Peach Street between Randolph and Mason Avenues, and the south entrance to Central Park. We are now at the 60% design phase; the site plan is below. A PDF of the site plan may be viewed on the [Town's website](http://www.capecharles.org) under the [Planning and Zoning](#) tab. The plans are also available for viewing in the Planner's office.

The trail alignment will be on both the east and west sides of the street, similar to north Peach Street. The trail will connect to the new paver walkway recently installed on the south side of Mason Avenue. A head-in diagonal parking median will be created with a semi-pervious surface. The median and parallel curb-side parking will provide 29 parking spaces. New lighting will be included for both the trail and parking median.

The planned improvements to the Central Park south entrance will correct problems at the intersection of the existing trail exiting the Park and the public alley, as well as providing a semi-pervious parking surface. This will minimize damage caused by vendors and other vehicles associated with events in the Park.
