Please join us in celebrating the town's 133<sup>rd</sup> birthday by participating in the Inaugural Cape Charles Day activities!

Community Clean-Up is from 9:00 AM to Noon. You can clean up your yard debris, road gutters, etc. and place the bags on the street curb. The Public Works crew will be picking up the bags on Saturday, continuing through the beginning of the following week.

Picnic in Central Park is from Noon to 2:00 PM. Mayor Dize has arranged for live music by Double Booked, and Town Council members will be grilling hamburgers and hotdogs for everyone! Sides and non-alcoholic beverages will also be served.

Staff will be manning departmental information tables providing a variety of information on upcoming events, public safety, volunteer opportunities, etc. and will be on hand to answer your questions. The Cape Charles Volunteer Fire Company will have a table and take reservations for smoke detector testing which they plan to schedule in April or May. The Citizens for Central Park will also have a table with information regarding their organization and the 2019 Summer Concert Series.

In the event of rain, the picnic will be moved to the Trinity United Methodist Church Social Hall on Tazewell Avenue.
