MASON AVENUE PAVING UPDATE

The Town received an update concerning the milling and paving on Mason Avenue. Branscome, VDOT's contractor, was in town last Friday, April 10th, distributing door hangers and installing "No Parking" signs. The work will begin on Wednesday, April 15th, weather permitting, and continue through April 29th. The milling and paving will begin at the intersection of Randolph Avenue / Fig Street / Route 184 and continue up Mason Avenue up to Pine Street. VDOT has requested no parking on Mason Avenue between the hours of 5:00 AM – 8:00 PM each day. The road will be in a rough condition for a few days until the paving overlay has been completed.

After the sections in town have been completed, Branscome will be paving Route 184 from Randolph Avenue to the Route 13 stoplight.

The Town is still awaiting a response regarding the proposed new parking plan to implement reverse angle parking on the north side of Mason Avenue.
